### Meals on Wheels - 1,300 Seniors over the age of 60.

In 2022, we served over 276,000 home delivered and congregate meals out of our 5 senior locations across Williamson and Burnet Counties

**Head Start**- 394 children from birth to age 5 each year.

Our Head Start program operates out of 12 Early Head Start and Head Start locations across our two-county area.

**Community Services** – 1,752 households helped in 2022.

Our Community Services programs are what makes OWBC a Community Action Agency. The programs and services provided by our Community Services department help transition low-income community members out of poverty through financial assistance, education, and coaching.

## COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



#### About the Program

The Comprehensive Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) provides qualifying households with payment assistance for energy costs. Benefits may cover multiple months.

#### Qualifications

- Must be a current resident of Williamson or Burnet County.
- In the last 30 days, household income levels up to 150% of federal poverty guidelines.
- Required application and documents, completed, signed, and emailed to utilities@owbc-tx.org or dropped off in mail slot at main office.
- Follow instructions per the application and include all required documentation. Incomplete applications with missing documentation will be denied.
- · Valid proof of each for all household members...
  - ID, U.S. citizenship or Legal Residence, Support of all forms of income (including employment pay stubs, SS/SSI/SSDI/RSDI award letters, child support, and SNAP must be current (within 30 days of application).
- Ensure each household member is listed to include minors and other household members.

#### Applying

- Visit <u>www.owbc-tx.org</u> and select "Community Services."
- Paper Application
  - You may print a paper application in English or Spanish. Applications are also available at the main office for pick-up. Complete paper applications may be scanned and emailed to utilities@owbc-tx.org or dropped off at the main office.
- Online Application
  - The online application is a two-step application process where you submit your household details and then upload the required documentation.
